

## Restorative Dentistry Dental Postgraduate Program

### One-Year Program

#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Application Requirements**

Prospective students should apply directly to the Restorative Dentistry Dental Postgraduate Program. The program application should be downloaded from the program website and completed in its entirety.

The application must be completed before it is reviewed by the Restorative Dentistry Director. The following items **MUST** be provided for an application to be considered complete.

#### **Application End date: February 1<sup>st</sup>**

- (1) Completed Program Application (available online). A curriculum vitae must be included with the application package.
- (2) Curriculum vitae must accompany the application.
- (3) If your dental school instruction was NOT in English, you must provide documentation of English language proficiency by submitting TOEFL scores. A minimum TOEFL iBT (internet-based test) of 84 is required. Please submit a notarized copy of your official TOEFL score report with this application. At this time, please do not submit scores electronically to the University of Michigan.
- (4) Three letters of recommendation. The letters should include an assessment of the applicant's dental background, knowledge, character, and clinical skills as well as potential for success in an advanced dental education program.
- (5) Statement of Purpose should be written by the applicant. The essay should be typewritten with 1 inch margins, size 12 font, and be no more than 1 page in length.
- (6) International applicants must be eligible for an appropriate visa to enter the United States. International applications are required to complete the International Student Supplemental Application Form. - (7) Transcripts of all dental education completed. Official transcripts of all dental education in the original language accompanied by a certified English translation are required.

- (8) All applicants will complete the Credentialing form and supply documentation as required. Form will be submitted to the Office of Patient Services for approval, receipt of approved credentialing form from the Director of Patient Services is required before proceeding any further. If not approved, then the student will not be admitted to the program and thus will be notified in writing.
- (9) The Director of Restorative Dentistry reviews the CV and additional information of the interested student to determine if they are qualified for the program. An on-site or telephone interview with the program director is required for acceptance to the program.

### **Applicants selected for Admission**

The program is for a 12 month period of study starting on 1 July, and ending the following year on June 30. Tuition for the one year program is \$35,000 (USD). If you are admitted to the program and are not a US citizen or permanent resident, you will need to submit financial certification documents in order for the University of Michigan to issue an appropriate I-20 for study. Do not submit financial documents now. Further information about the financial certification process will be provided to applicants selected for admission.
